- 203 dialysis patients received medication or transportation services from the Northeast Alabma Kidney Association.
- The Etowah Free Community Clinic provided healthcare to 302 patients, giving them some where to go instead of an emergency room.
- Of the 198 Boy Scouts in Etowah County, 98% plan to graduate high school, 96% plan to attend college, and 94% have learned to work with people different from themselves.
- Girl Scouts in Etowah County had 46 volunteer-led troops and 1,047 girls who served through staff-led outreach programming (Girl Scouting in the School Day) which benefits low-income and underserved girls.
- YMCA had 553 campers last year and reports one-third (184) of them were given scholarships for this structured, summer camp program.
- 1,022 persons received services of the Family Success Center's Financial Coach.
- 148 persons worked on a financial stabilty plan with 50% reporting reduction of debt and improved credit score.
